The (updated) Chemical History of a Candle

Jacob Martin is a carbon materials scientist and nanotechnologist that studies how we can manufacture carbon for use in the development of renewable energy. He is a trained physicist, chemist and chemical engineer having completed his BSc and Masters at the University of Auckland and PhD at the University of Cambridge in 2020. He has worked at the Cambridge Centre for Carbon Reduction in Chemical Technology in Singapore as a research fellow working with industry to decarbonise. Currently he is based in Department of Physics and Astronomy at Curtin University in Perth, Australia as a Forrest Fellow working on advanced carbon materials for decarbonisation in the Hydrogen Storage Research Group and Carbon Group.
