# CALL FOR APPLICATION FOR THE PARTICIPATION TO "ERASMUS+ BLENDED INTENSIVE PROGRAM" (BIP) AT THE UNIVERSIDAD POLITÉCNICA DE MADRID, UPM

The call for applications is here published for participating in "Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Program (BIP)" in *Sustainable, Advanced and Digital Manufacturing* from the 7th to the 23rd of January 2025. It will take place at the Universidad de Cádiz (E CADIZ 01), Spain.

BIPs are short-term Intensive Study Programs, which include in-person and online attendance and inperson a non line lessons. This program, in particular, will focus on research into the interdisciplinary areas of additive technologies, sustainable and digital manufacturing, covering common and innovative materials.

Develop advanced skills in engineering, creative thinking, and environmental sustainability with this course focused on responsible material practices, reusability, and recycling in manufacturing processes.

The call, having a deadline of 30/10/2024, is addressed to students from the University of Naples Federico II who, at the moment of application, are regularly enrolled in the PhD programme in Ingegneria dei Prodotti e dei Processi Industriali, at 1st and 2nd year of the following Second Cycle Degree programmes A.Y. 2024/2025:

- Materials Engineering
- Aerospace Engineering

and in the third year of the First Cycle Degree programme A.Y. 2024/2025 of Aerospace Engineering.

In-presence activities will take place from the 13th to the 17th of January 2025 at the University of Cadice (Cadiz), Spain. The selected students have to guarantee at least 5 days in presence. Furthermore, the activities will be taken online from the 7th to the 10th and from 21st to the 23rd of January.

All the activities will be held exclusively in English, thus, knowledge of English language is required and will be verified during the interview.

The students that will successfully complete the programme (virtual and physical mobility – both mandatory – and final project plus oral discussion) will receive 6 ECTS useful for the PhD programme or/and spend as additional knowledge, optional exam or thesis work for the second cycle degree programme students, and additional knowledge or thesis work for the first cycle programme students.

## 2. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The Selection Committee will select 10 students, 5 funded by Federico II sub conditionae (depending on the availability of the funds) and 5 without financial support. Applicants should be regularly enrolled for the a.y. 2024/25 in a PhD programme, in the 1st and 2nd year of the following study courses:

- Materials Engineering (Master degree)
- Aerospace Engineering (Master degree)

and at the third year of the First Cycle Degree programme of Aerospace Engineering.

To guarantee the interaction between different fields, the applicants will be selected in similar percentages between the two different areas to allow both courses to be represented.

#### 3. APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Interested students have to apply by the deadline of 30/10/2024

- Curriculum Vitae
- Certificato Storico by Segrepass
- Motivational letter in English (max 250 words)

The selection is the responsibility of the DICMAPI and DII of the University of Naples Federico II. It consists of both title evaluation and oral interview.

## CRITERIA FOR THE FORMULATION OF THE RANKING

The Commission will assign the score as follows:

- Max. 40 points for the evaluation of the academic career;
- Max. 30 points for the motivational letter and CV;
- Max. 25 points for the oral interview;
- Max. 5 points for English language knowledge.

In case of incomplete documentation, the application will be rejected.

# 5. AMOUNT OF THE FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTION
